



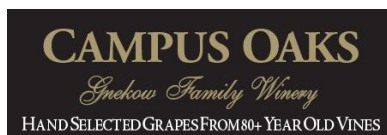
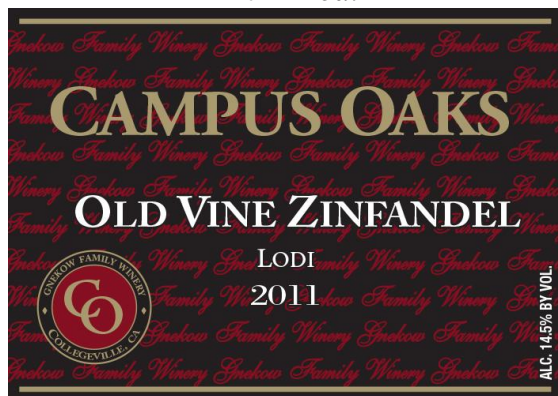

*A Marketplace Favorite!* With almost a dozen gold medals to its credit so far, it's easy to see why this varietal has become the **flagship** of our *Campus Oaks* line.

*“Sips n Tips”* Zinfandel is a variety of red grape planted in over 10 percent of California vineyards. DNA fingerprinting revealed that it is genetically equivalent to the Croatian grape *Crljenak Kaštelanski*, and also the variety *Primitivo* traditionally grown in the "heel" of Italy, where it was introduced in the mid 1800's. The grape found its way to the United States in the late-18th century, and became known by variations of the name "Zinfandel", a name of uncertain origin. It was first grown in hot houses for fresh grapes but became a winemaker's favorite when it arrived in California in the 1830's

We source grapes from four blocks of vineyards which average 80+ years of age; this Zinfandel delivers a great nose, wonderful mouth-feel, great flavors, and a silky-smooth finish.

**Tasting Notes:** The color is deep royal red. The nose is redolent with rich cherry, red and black fruits. On the pallet Jammy raspberry, blackberry and cherry predominate. The finish is rich, and silky with soft spices all wrapped with a nice blanket of vanilla.
